WORK EXPERIENCE TO ASSET RETIREMENT OPERATIVE



This interview with Brogan shares his thoughts about undertaking work experience at Centerprise and the opportunities this opened up for him.

You completed your work experience whilst still at college at Centerprise's Factory in Ystrad Mynach. Please describe why you chose Centerprise over any other employer?

Whilst carrying out work experience, I noticed that there were numerous opportunities at Centerprise and that it appeared to be a good company to work for.

What role did you initially undertake at Centerprise and what did this involve?
