- **Certified Data Security**

CiLifecycle operates to ADISA Standard 8.0, an industry-recognised certification aligned to UK GDPR requirements. This independently audited standard provides assurance that all devices are processed with secure data sanitisation and compliant handling.

- **Social Impact Beyond Hardware Donation**

Once equipment has been collected and processed by CiLifecycle, a significant proportion of eligible working devices are donated to Tameside Community Computers. Where devices require refurbishment, this work is carried out by trained volunteers under supervision. Through this process, individuals gain hands-on experience in diagnosing, repairing and preparing IT equipment for reuse, practical skills that are becoming increasingly scarce within the modern IT landscape. This contributes to personal development, builds confidence, and enhances future employability and career prospects.

- **Removing Barriers to Donation**

CiLifecycle are on public sector and enterprise frameworks, simplifying procurement and contractual processes. There's no need to segregate eligible equipment from other IT assets, we can handle the sorting, refurbishment, and secure disposal under a single contract, reducing storage and additional resources which can often be required when IT collections and donations are managed separately.
